There are three areas for which parents may reasonably be requested to make a payment or contribution:

Curriculum Contributions

Voluntary financial contributions for curriculum items and activities which the school deems necessary for students to learn the Curriculum.

Other Contributions

Voluntary financial contributions for non-curriculum items and activities that relate to the school's functions and objectives.

Extra-Curricular Items and Activities

Items and activities that enhance or broaden the schooling experience of students and are above and beyond what the school provides for free to deliver the Curriculum. These are provided on a user-pays basis.

Edrolo is a resource that is used at Carwatha College P-12. It is an interactive online video and exam resource for the VCE, providing students with the best opportunity to perform to their potential throughout the year. Students will have access to Edrolo during Term 4 2024. Edrolo accounts can be paid via Edrolo's secure server at www.edrolo.com.au If a student has not yet activated his/her Edrolo account, first go to www.edrolo.com.au/carwatha to get started.
